Predicting and preventing re-emergence of COVID-19

The appointee will participate in applied research to investigate the interplay between virus evolution, such as immune escape or case fatality rate, and public health interventions (e.g. vaccination and isolation). The postdoc will collect data and use agent-based modelling approach with other computational modelling methods to simulate the impact of the interventions on the virus evolution. He/She will also have opportunities to write papers and research proposals. The project is mainly funded by Hong Kong Institute for Advanced Study. The project can be extended.

Requirements

For the **Postdoc** position, applicants should possess a doctoral degree in biostatistics, bioinformatics, public health, epidemiology, infectious disease ecology, statistics, data science, mathematics, computer sciences, or a related quantitative and computational discipline.
